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Region of Valencia



Rice route across the northern marsh



Circular route signposted. It starts from the Rice Museum. This route goes across rural roads (with a small low level mountain stretch), between orange groves and rice fields. Starting point: Rice Museum.

3 hours on foot.
 Distance: 11 km.
 Difficulty: Low.
 Note: Access to the marsh route is forbidden during the hunting period, from October to February.



Route between rice fields across the southern marsh



Circular route through rural roads and rice fields of the southern marsh of the local area. Take care with the train tracks and the level crossing. The route runs along a former rice dryer. Starting / Ending point: Carrer de l'Arrós.

1h. 20 min. by bike.
 3h. 30 min. on foot.
 Distance: 10.7 km.
 Difficulty: low.



Route of the Castle Towers



The route joins all the restored towers of the Castle Bailey. It starts from the Tower of Reina Mora which is located on the 1st bend of Calvario Road (path to the Castle). Starting point: Tower of Reina Mora. Ending point: Calvario Road.

40 min. on foot.
 Distance: 1 km.
 Difficulty: low/medium



Path of "La Lloma" PRCV 336



Circular, registered and signposted route, that starts at the north of the cemetery. It continues to the "Segundo Collado" and reaches the Lighthouse. From there, it ascends through the top of the mountain to the Castle. You come back down the Second Bend of Calvario Road which will take you to the finishing point by the cemetery. PR-CV 336 signposted and registered. Starting and ending point: Road Nazaret - Oliva / Cemetery

4 h. 30 min on foot.
 Distance: 14 km.
 Difficulty: low / medium



Mouth of the Júcar river, south beaches and l'Estany

Circular route with a stretch of road on which you should take the necessary safety measures. It starts at the northern roundabout of La Bega bridge and heads towards the river mouth, then it leads to the Marenyet beach and to the lake of "Estany", (the area with the highest environmental value of Cullera). On our way back you will walk by the Marenyet Tower, along roads between fields, until La Bega bridge. Starting point: Northern Roundabout of La Bega Bridge. Ending point: Av. del Marenyet - La Bega Bridge.

3 h on foot.
 Distance: 9 km.
 Difficulty: Low.

Note: The access to the marsh route is forbidden during the hunting period, from October to February.



Path of the lake of Estany



Length: 15 min.
 Distance: 3.5 km.
 Difficulty: Low.
 Signposted route.



Route that goes to the Lake of Estany, it passes by the Sewage Treatment Station, arriving at Rabassades street and then at Nazaret-Oliva road up to the "Estudiant" entrance and finally, up to the Lake. Type of route: by bike until the Lake of Estany. There is a foot path bordering the lake (1.9 km) along rural roads and a stretch of road on which caution should be taken. Beginning point: Cami de la Moleta (rural road). Ending Point: Av. Del Estany

Cultural landscape of the river Júcar. Cycling route



The Júcar River is the common axis along this route, suitable for cycling and/or walking. It is a signposted route that connects the cities of Cullera and Sueca. This route allows highlights the mark that the river has left on the Cultural Landscape of the area, from its use for irrigation, the appearance of the first industries around it (mills), to its use as a river port... The Cultural Landscape of the Júcar River explains the different stages of the history of Cullera and the impact it has had on the development of the city.

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Lookouts

1 Lake of Estany



Natural landscape of singular beauty due to its botanical and faunistic value. The viewpoint guides us to a path that goes along the lake. Access: Carretera Nazaret-Oliva, direction Brosquil - Tavernes. 'L'Estudiant' entrance. Avenida Marenyet - Avenida de l'Estany.

2 Island of thoughts



Wonderful panoramic view of the entire bay of Cullera from the easternmost point of the coast. Access: Marqués de la Romana street (Lighthouse of Cullera).

3 Lighthouse cape



It is the only coastal stretch with cliffs in the province of Valencia. It is located in the Lighthouse district, next to the Chapel of "Los Navarros". Access: Lighthouse district, from Ermita street.

Mouth of river Júcar



This viewpoint brings us closer to the magnificent scenery of the north and south coast of Cullera. From 16:00 it is possible to see the fishing boats coming back to auction the fish in the fishmarket of the fishing port. This area is frequented by fishing enthusiasts.

Alt del Fort

It is also known as "Balcony of the Júcar". It shows the whole Region of la Ribera from different angles. Altitude 210 m. Access: Through a path from the rear side of the Castle and Replà de Sant Antoni street.



6 The Castle



From here you can admire the views of Cullera Bay in all its extension, the mouth and meander of the river Júcar, the rice fields, the fields, the lake of Estany and the old town. Access: Calvario Road on foot. Replà de Sant Antoni street by car or taking the tourist train (only in summer)

"Sants de la Pedra" Chapel



From the "Sants de la Pedra" Chapel you can see a wonderful landscape with rice fields and marsh surrounding it. Inside the chapel is the Rice Museum. Access: Nazaret - Oliva road Km 33. Ermita Sants de la Pedra street. Next to the Water Park.

ORNITHOLOGICAL TOURISM

Waterfowl observatory next to the lighthouse of Cullera

The ornithological tourism of Cullera is rich in variety both in species that inhabit its territory and those which follow migratory processes. More than 350 different species of birds find their natural refuge along the extension of the Albufera Natural Park and the marsh. They can be seen from the observatories and signposted routes of the city. This kind of tourism also promotes environmental education for schoolchildren, who can also learn, along the educational cycling routes, about the richness of birds in the area of Cullera. The Estany is the perfect location for birdwatching. There, you will find observatories, walkways and information boards surrounded by an outstanding scenery.
